

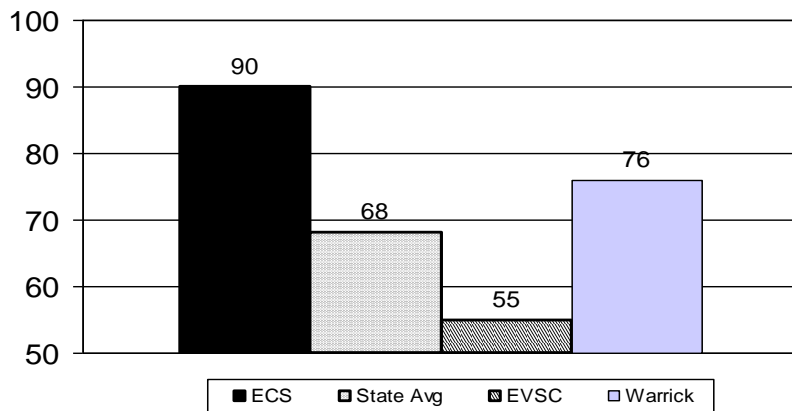
Evansville Christian School Standardized Test Results Spring 2011

**In 2011, 94.0% of our students passed the English portion with 42% Pass+.
95.5% of our students passed the Math portion with 53% Pass+.**

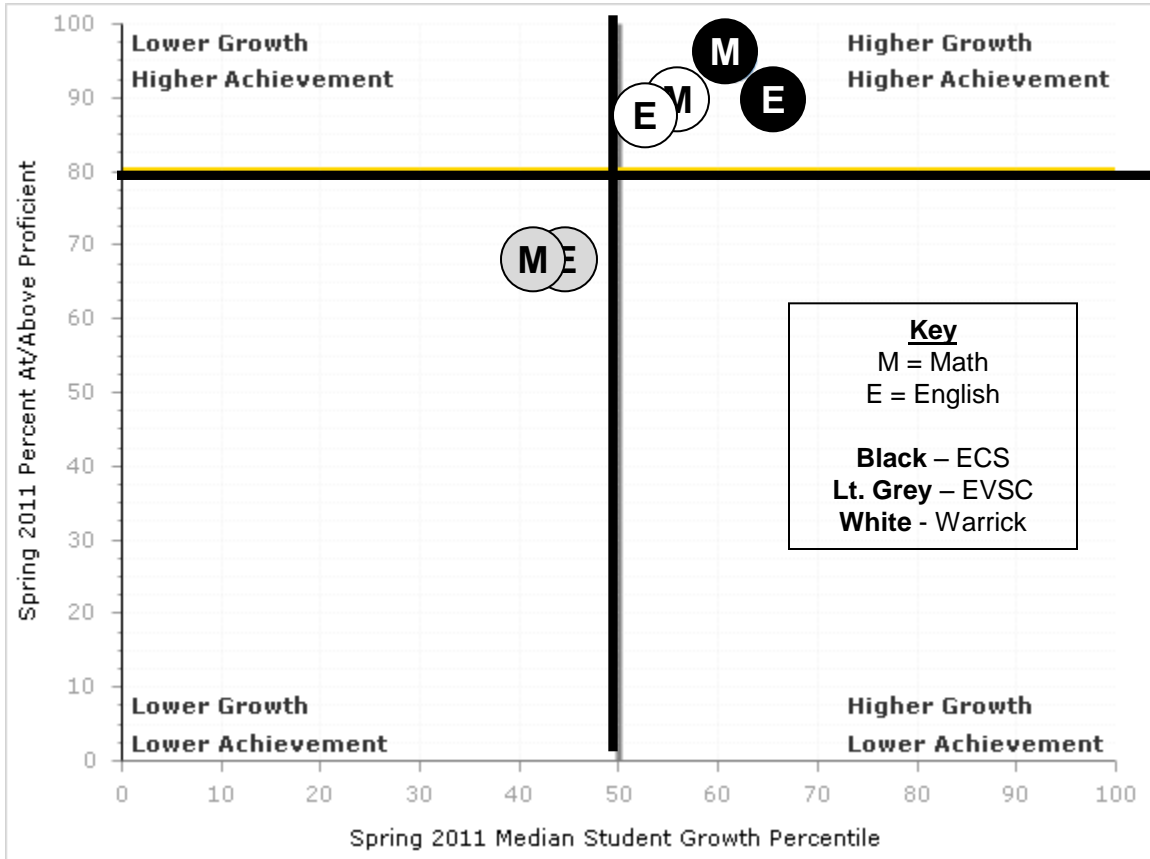
ECS has been "A"/Exemplary rated by IDOE (the highest category) every year.

Congratulations to our students and staff! Also, thank you parents for your support, which is a key to our success.

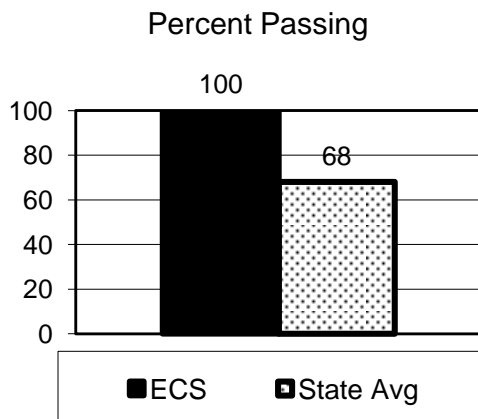
Indiana Growth Model (based on 2011 ISTEP results)

Algebra I End-of-Course Assessment (8th Grade Students)



In the Spring 2011, 55% of ECS' 8th grade students took Algebra I, compared to 25% throughout the State.

78% of ECS students scored in the Pass+ range, which demonstrates significant mastery of the required skills.

Every year, virtually 100% of ECS students pass the Algebra I ECA.
