**Special Opportunity for Incoming Kindergarten Students for the 2012-2013 School Year**

Approved Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGOs) are partnering with ECS to help Indiana families choose the school that best meets their needs and supports their values. In coordination with the State of Indiana’s voucher program, we are excited to announce a special grant opportunity for students entering kindergarten for the 2012-2013 school year.

By receiving an SGO grant for kindergarten, the student will then be eligible to apply for a voucher for future years, 1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade, subject to income limits. As currently designed, a voucher would cover 50-90% of ECS’ tuition. Further, to help families take advantage of this unique opportunity, ECS’ tuition assistance fund will help families with the cost of kindergarten not covered by an SGO grant (see below).

To qualify, a student must receive an SGO grant and meet ECS’ admissions standards. ECS will secure spots in the order received, subject to available space at each campus. To secure a spot, you must submit a completed ECS New Student Enrollment Form, a copy of the child’s birth certificate, and pay the \$175 family commitment fee (non-refundable). The ECS assistance eligibility will be confirmed upon verification that the student will receive an SGO grant.

All required forms (including the SGO Grant application) will be available from ECS’ East Campus office (4400 Lincoln Avenue). The SGO form must be submitted to ECS; ECS will deliver to the SGO. You must also submit a copy of your signed 2011 federal tax return and documentation of any non-taxable income, e.g. Social Security Income/Disability, Child Support, TANF, Food Stamps, etc.

Student/Family Eligibility

- The student must be an Indiana resident.
- The student must be entering kindergarten.
- Families must meet the income guidelines (see table) which are the same as the voucher income guidelines. The income is based on Adjusted Gross Income, plus other non-taxable income.

Family Financial Commitment

At the time of enrollment, a Commitment fee of \$175/family must be paid. The fee will be refunded if the student does not receive an SGO grant. The annual amount that the family will pay, **for 2012-2013**, is listed below (pay annually, semi-annually or on a 10-month plan).<sup>1</sup> The amount includes the cost of tuition and required fees (registration, book, supply, and technology). The family will also be responsible for before & after school care charges, meals, sports’ fees, etc.
