



2016-2017 TUITION & FEES

APPLICATION, REGISTRATION & COMMITMENT FEES

New Family Application Fee (for families who will be new to ECS or returning to ECS after more than one school year) \$ 50 Application Fee per Family

For re-registrations or after acceptance of new students: \$ 200 Registration & Commitment Fee per Family

These fees are non-refundable. The Registration & Commitment Fee secures your child(ren)'s place at ECS. Your enrollment serves as the basis for hiring teachers, purchasing books, and planning; thus, we take your registration as a commitment to attend. After acceptance of new students, the Registration & Commitment Fee must be paid within one week.

BOOK/SUPPLY & TECHNOLOGY FEES

Book & Supply fees:
All Students \$ 120 payable by June 1st and \$ 120 payable by July 1st

Technology fee:
All students \$ 30 payable by June 1st and \$ 30 payable by July 1st

Fees are non-refundable.
All payments may be made by June 1st.

Additional BASC Options:

- 1) Drop-In Care is \$7.00 per hour (minimum one hour) and based on available space (contact the school office before using).
- 2) North & Cullen students may ride the bus to East for After School Care (pay the East After School Care rate; but, no bus fee).
- 3) There will be a charge of \$10.00 for each 15 minutes that a student is picked up after closing time. After school care privileges may be revoked if late pick-up is misused.

BUS SERVICE: Bus will operate between the East, North, and Cullen Campuses. Contact the school office for information, including rates and times. Sign-up is by due June 1st and space is limited. Preference is given to families with students at more than one campus; then, first-come, first-served.

FOOD SERVICE: Breakfast = \$1.25 per meal Lunch = \$2.75 per meal Milk = \$0.35 per carton
(Food Service prices are projected and subject to change. Further, catered lunch prices may be higher for 6th - 8th grade at our Cullen Campus).

Important Financial Information

- The ACH option is available to families. A monthly statement, generated around the 15th of each month, will be sent detailing the charges to be debited from your bank account. If the 10-Month option is selected, the June & July fee payments will be paid via ACH; tuition/BASC/Bus/meals will be paid in August through May.
- If the June 1st fee payment, July 1st fee payment, or August 1st tuition are not paid by the due date, ECS reserves the right to withdraw the student and fill the spot with a student from the wait list.
- The Technology Fee does not cover the cost of a laptop/approved tablet/etc. required for students in 6th - 8th Grade.
- NEW - A one-year subscription to Renweb's Home App will be available to ECS parents on June 1, 2016, for the 16-17 School Year, at NO CHARGE.
- There is a \$20 change-over fee to change the enrollment options or payment plan. Further, only one change is permitted per year unless there are extenuating circumstances approved by administration.
- A late fee of \$20 will be charged to past due accounts and for each subsequent month until accounts are current.
- A \$25 charge will be assessed for all NSF checks/payment failures and may result in a family being required to pay in cash.
- A past-due balance of two months may be cause for student dismissal. At 90 days past due, formal collection proceeding may begin and additional costs incurred are the responsibility of the parent and will be added to the balance due ECS.
- Tuition does NOT include athletic fees, breakfast, lunch, class trips (5th-8th grade), extracurricular fees, participation fees, replacement book/agenda fees, late fees, NSF fees, or miscellaneous charges.
