# STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9, 1 Corinthians 12:12–13, Galatians 3:26–28).

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Romans 8:13–14; 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19–20; Ephesians 4:30, 5:18).

# STATEMENT ON HOLY SEXUALITY

**IN LEVITICUS 11:44 (AND REQUOTED IN 1 PETER 1:16), GOD SAYS, “BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY.” AT EVANSVILLE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL, WE COMMIT TO TEACHING ABOUT HUMAN SEXUALITY AND RELATIONSHIPS WITH SCRIPTURAL SUPPORT AND IN LINE WITH GOD’S INTENDED DESIGN, WHICH WE WILL REFER TO AS “HOLY SEXUALITY.”**

1. All people are beautifully created in God’s image in order to reflect God. Each person is distinctly created as either male or female in conformity with their biological sex and in complement to one another. (Genesis 1:26-27)
2. Sexual intimacy is God-designed and intended to be between a man and woman in marriage and within the boundaries of a covenantal marital commitment. (Genesis 2:18-25 & 1 Corinthians 7:2-5)
3. As a result of The Fall, sin has tainted everything including human sexuality. (Genesis 3:6)
4. Regardless of one’s sexual orientation and beliefs, we must love others. Love, in Biblical action, is refraining from all forms of abuse, slander, dehumanization, and/or oppression toward fellow humans, as it is an offense against God’s sacred image, which has been stamped upon all people. (Mark 12:31)
5. We must fight the desire to commit any sexual sin and honor God in our thoughts, words, and actions. (1 Corinthians 10:31)
6. We commit to walking alongside those struggling with sexual sin through the mutual pursuit of Jesus, which includes prayer, counsel, and coaching in other Biblical disciplines. (Ephesians 4:1-2)
